Foreword:

Beal Borr or Teampall Beilbharr - - - Church of the hill-gap, lies in Annamult between Bennettsbridge and Danesfort. The ruins of the 9th Century Church remain, and inside solidly built walls are seven monuments, five of which belong to the Holohan family of Knocktopher. There was no room for a graveyard outside owing to the church being located in a very narrow gap.

Inscriptions:

Name	Tomb No.	Inscription
Brown	1	(Small upright leaning back.) Here lies the body of David Brown who departed this life June ye 12 th 1743 aged 42 years. His daughter Mary Brown alias Grace wife to Jack Grace departed August ye 1 st 1756 aged 21 years. R.I.P.
Holohan (1)	2	(Upright leaning back near West end.) Here lieth the body of Mary Holohan who departed this life 27 th August 1770 aged 67. Also her sister Johanna Holohan departed June 1755 aged 25. Lord have mercy on their Souls. Also the body of John Holohan who departed May 17 th 1779 aged 92.
Holohan (2)	3	(Broken Altar Tomb close to above. Only name to be seen. Looks rather like a Priests Tomb.) --- Holohan ---.
Holohan (3)	4	(Upright leaning back.) Here lieth the remains of Richard Holohan who departed December

		1800. His son John died 1805 aged 45.
Holohan (4)	5	(Thick small upright leaning back. D.O.M.) God be merciful to the Soul of James Holohan who died 1759.
Holohan (5)	6	(Upright Tomb Stone up against North wall.) Of your charity pray for the Soul of Richard Holohan, Knocktopher who died 18 th November 1873 in his 79 th year. Also the remains of his wife Anastatia alias Connolly who died 14 th Sept. 1890 aged 78. Also their son John who died March 19 th 1902 aged 41 years and his daughter Angela Holohan who died March 5 th 1898 aged 5 years. R.I.P.
Kelly	7	(Upright under East Window) This stone was erected by Mr. James Kelly in memory of his brother Mr. Robert Kelly who died May 18 th in the Year of Our Lord 1779 aged 63 years. R.I.P.
