### Foreword:

Kyleballykeefe Church was a chapel of ease to the parish church of Tullaghanbroge. The ancient church now in ruins is described by Carrigan, (Vol. III, p 436). The patron was St. Nicholas and there is a holy well nearby. In 1701 Theobald Butler of Ballykeefe directed his remains to be buried in the chapel. No inscription to record this was found. Recording of monuments in the graveyard was started at the left of the entrance gate.

Doran (1)	2	Erected by Thomas Doran, Dearyhill in memory of his father John Doran died 5 <sup>th</sup> August 1826 aged 84 and his mother Anistice Doran alias Dunn died June 2 <sup>nd</sup> 1831 aged 82.
Doran (2)	3	Erected by Mrs Judith Doran alias Slattery in memory of husband Patrick Doran, Gaulstown died 1 <sup>st</sup> September 1895 aged 66.
Herbert (1)	4	Here lies Edmond Herbert died 1 <sup>st</sup> February 1769 aged 67, also his wife Mary alias Saunders died 29 <sup>th</sup> September 1788 aged 82.
Herbert (2)	5	Here lies David Herbert died 20 <sup>th</sup> April 1758 aged 31 also his wife Bridget Herbert died 28 <sup>th</sup> July 1789 aged 56.

Dalton	6	In memory of James Dalton, Bridge Street, Callan died 2 <sup>nd</sup> September 1914. His son John Dalton died 19 <sup>th</sup> August 1951. His wife Margaret died 8 <sup>th</sup> August 1953. Erected by daughter Mary, U.S.A. Tomb maker – Molloy, Callan
Mulrony	7	(Second row to left of Gate) Erected by Bridget Mulrony alias Corcoran of Ballykeefe in memory of husband William Mulrony died November 8 <sup>th</sup> 1806 aged 70, also son Edmond died October 17 <sup>th</sup> 1817 aged 27.
Wallace	8	To the memory of Nicholas Wallace, Ballykeefe, Cuffesgrange died 1 <sup>st</sup> August 1950 aged 30, also his father Richard Wallace died 1 <sup>st</sup> June 1951 aged 79 and his mother Margaret Wallace died 10 <sup>th</sup> January 1954 aged 76.
Corkran	9	(At Church wall) Here lies Philip Corkran died 4 <sup>th</sup> June 1750 aged 25.
Cashen	10	Here lies Thomas Cashen died 19 <sup>th</sup> September 1775 aged 67, also Ann Cashen alias Tearney died 7 <sup>th</sup> May 1750 aged 37.
Forgarty	11	Thomas Fogarty was born 5 <sup>th</sup> March 1740 died 27 <sup>th</sup> December 1768.
Bowe	12	Erected by My Michael Bowe in memory of two of his sons – Michael died 13 <sup>th</sup> February 1806 aged 22. Jno died 3 <sup>rd</sup> May 1799 aged 11 years.
Darcy	13	Erected by Miss Lizzie Darcy, Trenton, New Jersey, America in memory of her parents Walter Darcy died 2 <sup>nd</sup> December 1887 aged 68 and Annie Darcy died 20 <sup>th</sup> April 1891 aged 60. John Darcy died 2 <sup>nd</sup> September 1935, Mary Darcy died 16 <sup>th</sup> June 1954, Nora Cleary died 21 <sup>st</sup> April 1958.
Ryan	14	Erected by Patrick Ryan in memory of his father Thomas Ryan died 25 <sup>th</sup> January 1772 aged 41. Also his son James died November 179 --.
Egan (1)	15	Here lies James Egan died 15 <sup>th</sup> January 1766 aged 62.
Egan (2)	16	Here lies Joan Egan alias Marnel died 15 <sup>th</sup> September 1757 aged 40 years, likewise the body of Thomas Egan (date not filled in)
