Foreword:

Thornback Church now a ruin was once an "Ecclesia" or Parochial Church. Patron was Saint Brendan. The Cemetery is triangular in shape and the Church was sited on top of a hill in the centre. In all we recorded 138 tombstones but there are many more there broken, overturned and underground.

Far corner of Cemetery – South East) Of your charity pray for the Soul of Bridget Andrews, Dean St., Kilkenny who died July 17 th 1902 aged 54. Her husband James died 5 th October 1915 aged 74. Also their sons William who died 4 th December 1915 and Patrick died June 1916. Mary Andrews died 16 th December 1928. R.I.P. Stonemason - Brennan, Kilkenny Note: Bride Andrews who had a fashionable Dress shop in Dublin for many years died in the Autumn of 1971 and is interred here. Name not yet on stone.
Betts	2	(Iron Cross between William Cody and James Butler) In memory of Nanny Betts who died Sept. 1891 aged 28.
Boe	3	(Large upright leaning back - on top of hill) Erected by Patrick Boe of Thornback in memory of his son John Boe who died 1800 aged 21. Daughter Margaret died 5 th November 1840 aged 20 and his son Martin died May 20 th 1844 aged 20. Note: Rather difficult to read, dates not clear.

Bolger (1)	4	(Latin Cross with "in memorium". Close to ruins of Church.) Sacred to the memory of John Bolger of Troyswood aged 66 (? date) and his wife Mary who died 20 th May 1892 aged 68 also their 2 children died young. Their Grandson Louis died March 24 th aged 11 months. Also Patrick Bolger died 26 th May 1900 aged 48. Michael Bolger died March 14 th 1917 aged 65. R.I.P. Erected by Michael Bolger, Troyswood. (On side of Cross) – Also Mrs Maria Bolger who died 5 th Feb. 1945 aged 80 & her sons, James died 16 th May 1953 & John died 14 th June 1954, Patrick died 6 th January 1966 Stonemason - Hoban. Kilkenny
Bolger (2)	5	(Upright leaning forward on slope of hill and below Gregg.) Erected by Catherine Bolger alias Doran in memory of her husband Patrick Bolger who died May 11 th 1835 aged 56 and 6 of their children.
Bulger (4)	6	(Upright to right of John Delany) This stone erected by Michael Bulger to the memory of his wife Anastatia Bulger alias Purcell of Keatingstown and 3 of their children. She died 4 th January 1785 aged 50 years. R.I.P.
Bulger (5)	7	(Small upright outside railing also near John Delany.) Erected by Anne Bulger in memory of her sister Margaret Bulger who died May 1818 aged 64.
Bulger (6)	8	(Large wide upright, top of hill, two rows behind railings.) Erected by Bridget Bulger alias Summers in memory of her husband Michael Bulger of Patrick St. who departed this life February 28 th 1827 aged 47.
Bulger (7)	9	(Narrow upright near Church wall and beside Bolger Cross) Erected by John Bulger in memory of his wife Margaret alias Healy who died 1801 aged 74.
Bradley	10	(Small Latin Cross with I.H.S. Large railed in enclosure.) Erected by William Bradley, Dean St. Kilkenny in memory of his wife Mary Bradley who died 1928 aged 72. Also her husband William Bradley died 24 th November 1923 aged 75. Stonemason - Gargan. Kilkenny. Note: Above William Bradley was a Carpenter, his wife was Fleming.
Breen or Brennan	11	(Large upright now tilted over and only part of name visible.) Here lieth the body of William Bre---- who died June 1800 -- his wife Elizabeth died July 1809.
Brennan (1)	12	(Upright, now leaning back.) Here lies the body of Catherine Brennan alias Glinnan who died 5 th April 1799 aged 37. Also his wife Margaret Brennan alias Reade died October 27 th 1837 aged 41 with 5 children. Also his mother Anne Brennan alias Sexton who died August 1834. Note: Unable to decipher details of husband, probably married twice.

Buggy	13	(Broken stone lying down, part of inscription missing.) Ana Buggy of Ballyvan in memory of her husband Richard who died November 20 th 1838. Also her father Thomas -----.
Butlar (1)	14	(Small upright.) Here lieth the body of James Butlar who died March 11 th 1773 aged 37.
Butler (2)	15	(Small upright next to Glennon.) Here lie the remains of Tobias Butler who died October 1829 aged 70. R.I.P.
Butler (3)	16	(Latin Cross with I.H.S. inside entrance Gate.) In memory of John Butler, Bonnettstown who died October 13 th 1924 aged 28 years.
Cahill	17	(Small upright behind railings, near L. Murphy and Keogh.) God be merciful to the Soul of William Cahill who died February ye 5 th 1803 aged 27.
Cantwell (1)	18	(Concrete Cross with marble plaque.) In loving memory of Bridie Cantwell of Dunmore, Kilkenny who died July 18 th 1913 aged 19.
Cantwell (2)	19	(Stone Cross on concrete base.) Erected by Michael Cantwell, Greens Hill in memory of his father and children who died young. R.I.P. (No date given.)
Cantwell (3)	20	(Concrete Latin Cross.) In loving memory of Martin Cantwell, Parnell St. who died March 7 th 1931 aged 20 and his brother Thomas died March 25 th 1931 aged 22. Their father James Cantwell died 1933 aged 50.
Cashin	21	(Small upright now leaning forward.) Erected by Margaret Cashin in memory of her son who died March 1807.
Cody (1)	22	(Small upright now leaning back.) Here lie the bodies of William Cody who died 1755 aged 82. Also children and grandchildren.
Cody (3)	23	(Large upright now leaning forward. Top of hill.) Here lieth interred the body of Mary Cody alias Cartwright wife to John Cody of the City of Kilkenny who died 4 th September 1791 aged 43. Also above John Cody.
Cooke	24	(Small upright now lying flat.) Here lies the body of Bridget Cooke daughter to Mary Cooke. She died 17-- aged 22. (Difficult to read).
Costelloe (2)	25	(Leaning back.) God be merciful to the Soul of Robert Costelloe who died 23 rd July 1756 aged 56 and 4 children.

Costelloe (3)	26	(Large upright to left of Ryan No. 8) Pray for the Souls of the deceased family. This was erected by John Costelloe in memory of his father Keeran Costelloe. (no date)
Dalton (2)	27	(Upright now lying down. Nicely carved) Erected by John Dalton of Troyswood in memory of his beloved wife Bridget Dalton who died 2 nd August 1875 aged 55 years. Also one child died young. Also in memory of his father and mother. R.I.P.
Dalton (3)	28	(Upright now down, half way up hill and near boundary wall at road.) Erected by Julia Dalton, Killaree in memory of her beloved husband Patrick who died October 10 th 1910 aged 71. Also her son James aged 7 and her daughter Katie aged 2. Stonemason - Gargan. Kilkenny.
Dalton (4)	29	(Slab on outside wall of Church) Erected by Thomas & William Dalton of Troyswood in memory of their beloved mother Anastatia alias Lannen who died December 14 th 1870 aged 59. Also their father John Dalton died 8 th May 1896 aged 90. Their brother Patrick died May 4 th 1883 aged 40. Also the children of William, Joseph & Richard who died young.
Dalton (5)	30	(Upright with Cross close to Bradley & Maher No. 1) Erected by Richard Dalton of Goose Hill in memory of his father Richard who died May 31 st 1847 aged 70. Also his mother Catherine Dalton who died June 1840 aged 56. His wife Bridget Dalton died June 4 th 1892 aged 70. The above Richard Dalton died 30 th July 1899 aged 79 years with 4 children who died young.
Davy	31	(Upright with surrounding rail) In loving memory of Edward Davy of Dean St. Kilkenny who died 21 st February, 1927 aged 98. Also his daughter Lizzie died 9 th November 1918 and his wife Margaret Davy died 18 th November 1928 aged 75. Also his daughter Margaret died March 31 st 1930. Stonemason - Hoban. Kilkenny
Delahanty	32	(Upright directly behind Bolger Cross. Latin Cross on back.) Erected by James Delahanty of Keatingstown in memory of his beloved children – Patrick died 9 th July 1879 aged 17. James died 31 st July 1880 aged 20. Michael died 1915. John Delahanty died 20 th October 1940 aged 83 and his wife Alice died 29 th April, 1917. Edward J. Delahanty died 17 th . November, 1940.
Delany (1)	33	(Celtic Cross near Lanigan & James Delany) Erected by Thomas Delany of Green St. Kilkenny in memory of his daughter Margaret Mary who died September 1904 aged 57. R.I.P.
Delany (2)	34	(Fallen upright next to Delany (1) & near King.) Erected by James Delany, Kilkenny in memory of his children – Anastatia died August 10 th 1868 aged 14. Mary died September 17 th 1880 aged 20 years. Teresa died June 6 th 1886 aged 22. Peter died June 28 th 1888 aged

		25. Joseph died June 28 th 1889 aged 27. Ellen who died young. Also his mother Mary Delany died November 13 th 1851 aged 60. Martin Delany died January 2 nd 1854 aged 80. Also the above James died 11 th October 1891 aged 67 and his wife Margaret died 18 th January 1898 aged 70.
Delany (3)	35	(Small upright with Lamb on top. Lower down the hill than Doody.) To the memory of Patrick Delany, Keatingstown who died 24 th March 1877 aged 66. His wife Mary Delany alias Lanigan died 27 th May 1874 aged 60.
Delany (4)	36	(High monument with Cross on top.) Erected by Mrs Joanna Delany in memory of her beloved husband Patrick Delany who died August 6 th 1897 aged 65. Also his brother Michael died November 6 th 1871 aged 30. Also James died June 2 nd 1879 aged 46. Laurence died young also Timothy, Edward, John & Thomas. On side of monument --- Also his sisters Josephine, Bridget & Margaret who are interred here.
Delany (5)	37	(Fallen upright in front of No. 4) Erected by Edmund & Michael Delany, Threecastles in memory of their father Patrick Delany who died September 23 rd 1841 aged 61. Also their mother Mary Delany alias Fogarty who died October 20 th 1837 aged 46.
De Loughry (1)	38	(Upright with railing, next to John Fitzpatrick) Pray for the Souls of Richard De Loughry who died 18 th February 1895 aged 49 and his wife Bridget nee O'Brien who died 11 th January 1901 aged 51. Also their son John who died 22 nd April 1907 aged 33. Patrick Francis De Loughry died at Cambridge, Mass. U.S.A. 4 th November 1913 aged 34. Peter De Loughry, Parliament St. Kilkenny died 23 rd October 1931 aged 47. Mayor of Kilkenny 1919-1925. Senator Seanad Eireann 1922-1925. Deputy Dail Eireann Carlow-Kilkenny 1927-1931 Also his daughters Sheila Frisby died 23 rd Jan. 1944 aged 27 and Mary Elizabeth De Loughry died 24 th Feb 1946 aged 31. R.I.P His wife Winifred - ----- Note: Oldest son of Peter above, Richard (Dick) died 5 th Sept. 1972 aged 60 years and is interred in St. Kieran's Cemetery.

Also his wife Mary Dermody alias Palmer who died April 26 th 1821 aged 64 years. The above John Dermody died January 29 th 18 --- Also Mary Dermody aged 30.
Doheny	40	(Base only of Cross. Next to Naddy. Date impossible to read.) To the memory of Mrs Anne Doheny ----- . "She always made home happy. They had marked her cheerful spirit when bearing, one by one her many burdens up the hill til all was done."
Doody	41	(Large Celtic Cross. Iron surround. Near Phelan No. 2) Erected by Mary Doody in memory of her beloved father Thomas Doody, Dean St. Kilkenny who died January 7 th 1885 aged 75. Also his wife Margaret Doody died 1886 aged 70. Daughter Margaret died 4 th August 1881 aged 30. R.I.P.

Doughney (1)	42	(High upright next to Mrs Anne Doheny and near Purcell No. 1) Erected by John Doughney, Troyswood in memory of his father Philip Doughney who died January 11 th 1861 aged 55, his sister Anne died October 23 rd 1863 aged 2 years. The above John Doughney of Kilkenny died 15 th March 1890 aged 35, also his daughter Cathleen aged 8 months.
Doughney (2)	43	(Upright close to Keary & Morris. Top of hill.) Erected by Margaret Doughney in memory of her sister Mary who died May 8 th 1805 aged 33.
Dowling (1)	44	(Celtic Cross near wall to left of entrance.) Erected by Daniel Dowling, Dunningstown in memory of his daughter Nellie Dowling who died 8 th May 1939. His father Patrick Dowling and his brother John. Also his son Thomas who died young.
Dowling (2)	45	(Small low slanting slab with stone surround) In loving memory of Mary Anne Dowling who died November 6 th 1943. Her father died April 7 th 1929 and her mother died February 22 nd 1930. R.I.P. Stonemason - Gargan.
Dowling (3)	46	(Celtic Cross with unusual sunburst. Stone and Iron surround.) In loving memory of Michael Dowling of James' St. Kilkenny who died 30 th August 1889 aged 51. Mourned by his sorrowing widow. Here also lie 2 of their children. Charlie Dowling died June 26 th 1928 aged 28 years.
Dowling (4)	47	(Large upright next to No. 3 above, inside same railings) Erected by Catherine Dowling in memory of her husband Mr. Patrick Dowling of James' St. who died July 1836 aged 66. Also their daughter Margaret Dowling who died 26 th --- 1835.
Dowling (6)	48	(One of five inside a modern railing.) Erected by Thomas Dowling in memory of his father Robert Dowling of Dunningstown who died August 1790. Also his mother Catherine Dowling alias Dulanty died May 1767 aged 60. Also his sister Mary aged 36.
Dowling (7)	49	(D.O.M.) Here lieth the body of Thomas Dowling who died March 10 th 1756. Also the body Mary Dowling alias Martin died November 6 th 1767 aged 37.
Dowling (8)	50	(D.O.M.) Here lies interred the body of Robert Dowling of Fashaugh who died 4 th May 1778 aged 63. R.I.P.
Dowling (9)	51	(Upright between Neary Cross & Church.) Erected by Danl. Dowling in memory of his father John who died October 1792 aged 60 years. Also his wife Johanna alias Magrath died October ----- (buried.)
Dunne	52	(Celtic Cross with ornate railing around plot. No date. Inscription very clear.) Richard Dunne. Watergate, Kilkenny
English (1)	53	(Large Celtic Cross. Top of hill and near Maher No. 2.) Sacred to the memory of Michael English of Church Lane who departed this

Fleming (1)	59	<p>(On top of mound. Celtic Cross.)</p> <p>Erected by Catherine Fleming of the Rock in memory of her beloved husband Michael Fleming who died May 1st 1926 aged 72. Also his wife Catherine died 15th March 1935 aged 81 and their daughter Mary Anne Corbett died 27th April 1951 aged 61 years.</p> <p>Note. Public House at Rock now owned by Campions.</p>
Fleming (3)	60	<p>(Large upright right on side of Church.)</p> <p>Erected by Mary Fleming of Ballinalina in memory of her brother Michael Fogarty who died September 10th 1856 aged 19 years, also her father Joseph Fogarty died 1848 aged 70. Also her mother Margaret Fogarty alias Kiffe died June 1850 aged 66. Her daughter Bridget Kelly alias Fleming died 1870 aged 27 years also her baby who died young.</p>
Fogarty (1)	61	<p>(Only bottom half of this tomb-stone survives. Difficult to read.)</p> <p>Bridget Fogarty alias ----- in memory of her grand-daughter - - - who died June 1835 and 2 of her infant children.</p>
Fogarty (2)	62	<p>(Row behind English Cross, on top of hill.)</p> <p>The body of James Fogarty who died 1789 aged 26. Erected by son</p>

Fogarty (3)	63	(Upright with small Celtic Cross. Top of hill) Erected by Patrick Fogarty of Troyswood in memory of mother Ellen Fogarty who died April 2 nd 1882 aged 78. His father John Fogarty died -----
Fogarty (5)	64	(Upright with Cross – next to Church wall.) Erected by Catherine Fogarty, King St., Kilkenny in memory of her husband Joseph Fogarty who died December 12 th 1873 aged 68.
Fogarty (6)	65	(Mural Monument with urn on top. I.H.S.) Sacred to the memory of John Fogarty late of Troyswood who died 16 th March 1835 aged 70 and his wife Mary Fogarty alias Bolger who died July -- - 1849 aged 68. Also their daughter Anastatia Delany who died 9 th May 1847 aged 45.
Glennon (1)	66	(Large upright near Fleming Celtic Cross. Recently cleaned.) Erected by John Glennon of Threecastles in memory of his father Mr. Michael Glennon who died 23 rd November 1835 aged 72. Also his mother Margaret Glennon alias Keoughan who died 4 th July 1846 aged 90, together with his three children Margaret, Anne & Catherine who died young. Joseph Glennon 12 th February 1920, his wife Elizabeth died 10 th May 1916 and his son John died 10 th June 1944. R.I.P. Amen.
Glinnan (2)	67	(Close to above and also recently cleaned. Small upright.) Here lies the body of Mr. Michael Glinnan who died July 29 th 1755 aged 42.
Gorman (1)	68	(Upright beside O'Gorman and near Neary Cross) Erected by Mary Gorman alias Murphy in memory of her beloved husband Dennis Gorman who died October 1800 aged 64 with 2 of their children.
Gregg	69	(Large upright with curb stone. Right hand side of hill.) Erected by Mary Anne Gregg of the Black Abbey, Kilkenny in memory of her beloved husband Cornelius Gregg who died 27 th November, 1864 aged 35. Also her daughter Anastasia who died 19 th December 1864 aged 8 years. Also her son John who died young. Here lie also the above Mary Anne Gregg who died 31 st Dec. 1894 aged 65 and her sons, Michael who died 27 th July 1934 aged 80. James Gregg died 8 th Nov. 1942 aged 82 and his wife Mary Anne died 7 th November 1922 aged 63, and their son Martin died in 1901 aged 11 and Joseph died 15 th May 1945 aged 80 years. Note: Above Mary Anne wife of James Gregg was a Gleeson of Rose Inn Street (Poulterers). A daughter Rose died in 1970. -- name not yet inscribed on stone. James Gregg had a Fruit and Veg. shop in High St. which has been purchased by Sherwoods and is being reconstructed (1972). A son of James Gregg and brother of Rose Gregg was Sir Cornelius Gregg who died some years ago.

Heffernan (4)	73	(Upright now leaning back, close to No. 3 above) Erected by Ed. Heffernan, Palmerstown in memory of his wife Mary Heffernan alias Kealy who died 1800 aged 42.
Heffernan (5)	74	(Small stone lying flat and close to entrance gate.) Erected by John Heffernan, Rathilty in memory of his mother Catherine Heffernan who died 30 th December, 1900 aged 72. Also their daughter Maria who died March 1904 aged 30.
Hickey (1)	75	(Large upright now leaning forward) Erected by Richard Hickey in memory of his father John Hickey of Dunningstown who died in 1825 aged 85. Also his mother Catherine Hickey alias Purcell who died 1829 aged 78. Also ----- (rest buried).
Hickey (2)	76	(Large wide upright to left of Bolger Cross, near railing.) Erected by John & William Hickey of ----- in memory of their father & mother, - Richard Hickey of Keatingstown. Also of Honoria Hickey daughter of William Hickey, she died November 1809 aged 27.
Hogan (1)	77	(Tomb similar to Robert Kelly.) Erected by Patrick Hogan, Talbots Inch in memory of his beloved father John who died 15 th January 1882 aged 66. Also his mother Mary died January 9 th 1891. Also his daughter Margaret died March 17 th 1906 and his son Patrick died March 18 th 1922. The above Patrick Hogan died 24 th August 1926. Also his wife Johanna died 15 th October 1944. R.I.P. Stonemason - Hoban.
Hogan (2)	78	(Altar Tomb beside No. 3 and close to English Cross.) Erected by Cornelius Hogan in memory of his father Edward Hogan, Gaulstown who died 18 th October 1825 aged 86. Also his wife Mrs Catherine Hogan alias Brennan died 4 th April 1827 aged 70. Mathew Hogan died 10 th August 1810 aged 20 and daughter Mary Hogan died 1800 aged 23.
Hogan (3)	79	(Small upright beside above.) Pray for the Soul of Edmund Hogan who died 1 st March 1727 aged 50. Also his son Loughlin Hogan died February 2 nd 1755 aged 30 years and Roger Hogan of the Old Deerpark his son also who died February --- aged 28.
Holden	80	(Small marble shield shaped plaque near entrance.) In loving memory of Margaret & Patrick Holden of Talbots Inch. Also their son Patrick. (No dates given.)

Holland	81	(Large Celtic Cross with stone surround.) In loving memory of Kattie wife of Michael Holland, Troysgate, Kilkenny who died 28 th May 1886 aged 28. Also her husband Michael Holland died September 1904. Stonemason - Hoban, Kilkenny.
Horohan	82	(Slab (broken) next to Fogarty No. 1) Erected by Mrs Horohan in memory of Bridget Gorman aged 7 years.
Keary	83	(Large upright near Bolger Cross & Delahanty.) Erected by James Keary of the City of Kilkenny in memory of his wife Catherine alias Mahony who died 1810 aged 34 - - - - also children.
Kelly (1)	84	(Fine upright with Cross on top, on the level not far from entrance.) Erected by Robert Kelly, Irishtown, Kilkenny in memory of his father Thomas Kelly who died 25 th January 1873 aged 45. Also Anastasia wife of Thomas Kelly died 8 th May 1895 aged 65. The above Robert Kelly died March 4 th 1929 aged 68 and his wife Marianne Kelly alias Hughes died 14 th May 1940 aged 76.
