Foreword:

The small church at Kilmademoge (Kilmodimogue) dating to the Anglo-Norman invasion was in ruins for a long time by the beginning of the 20th century (Carrigan Vol. III, p 462). The surrounding graveyard was walled in by the Kilkenny Board of Guardians and contains some inscribed monuments.

Inscriptions:

Name	Tomb No.	Inscription
Brown	1	Thomas Brown January 5 th 1781 aged 79 with 3 grandchildren, also Thomas, January 2 nd 1785 aged 12 years. Erected by their father John Brown son to the above Thomas.
Clear	2	Erected by Patrick Clear, Leonllin to memory of daughter Anne Clear departed April 9 th 1802 aged 23 years and son William, September 7 th 1807 aged 22.
Nolan	3	Heare lyes the body of Edmond Nolan 1746 aged 56.
Nowlan	4	Erected by Edmond Nowlan in memory of father Patrick Nowlan died February 10 th 1788 aged 70, also his wife Elinor alias Keane, September 29 th 1800 aged 78 with two of their grandchildren.
Reade	5	Erected by John Reade in memory of his father Robert Reade, died 28 th October 1754 aged 47, also his wife Mary died August 1760 aged 53 with 3 of their children. Also Thomas Reade son to said John, April 27 th 1793 aged 15.

Murphy	6	Erected by Martin Murphy, Gowran in memory of his father Thomas, died January 1843 aged 73, also his brother James died August 29 th 1844 aged 23.
