Foreword: by M.M. Phelan

The ancient church is believed to have been erected before 1000 A.D. and is now in ruins. Monuments within the church date from the 13th, 16th, 17th, 18th and later centuries. The oldest inscription dates to 1534 (see No. 52 below) and commemorates Thomas Howling (Holden). The finest monument at Kilree is the altar tomb of the Comerfords and the St. Legers dated 1622 (see No.24 below). This tomb may have been made by the Kerin's school. Five monuments commemorate the Izod family who held land from the Duke of Ormonde and build a fine house in 1672 called Chapel Izod, now in ruins. For description of Kilree Church, Round Tower and ancient monuments see Richard Laharts's "*History of the Parish of Dunnamaggin*" Page 23 to 39, and Canon Carrigans' History too. There is also an article by M. M. Phelan 'Kilree' in *Old Kilkenny Review*, 1973, No. 25, pp 16-28.

Baron	2	(Large upright tomb stone leaning forward near Eliz Meighan N.T. and Jas. Cahill) Erected by Pierce Baron and Honor Baron alias Costelloe in memory of his

		father James Baron of Goodwins Garden who departed this life Dec 24 th 1802 aged 73. Also Catherine Baron alias Carrol. Also his son Patrick Baron died 23 rd August 1802 aged 35 years, with his mother Catherine alias Corcoran, she died May 27 th 1802 with 3 of Patrick Baron's children. Lord have mercy on their souls, Amen.
Barry (1)	3	(Celtic Cross between Jas. Davis and Patrick Phelan) Erected by Thomas Barry, Kells in memory of his parents James Barry who died 2 nd Feb 1905 aged 85 and Hanore nee Cody died January 1907 aged 88. Also his brother James Barry who died 23 rd June 1935 aged 67 and John who died 11 th November 1935 aged 74. Side inscription: Mary Barry died 28 th March 1941 aged 84 years. Her brother Thomas died 11 th April 1944 aged 77 years. Tomb maker – Molloy, Callan
Brennan (1)	5	(Large upright tomb stone between James Purcell & Mrs Catherine Purcell) Erected by the Widow Brennan alias Mann or Marm? (unclear) of Newtownbaker in memory of her husband John who died June 21 st 1822 and three children who died young.
Brennan (2)	6	Erected by Martin Brennan, Danganmore in memory of his grandparents Bridget Davis died 11 August 1913 aged 63 and James Davis died 28 th November 1927 aged 83. Also his parents James Brennan died 27 th Jan. 1941 aged 63 and Mary Brennan died 15 th Feb. 1959 aged 71. Also his sisters Bridget died young and Sr. Mary Dominic died 24 th Nov. 1980 aged 66 interred in Merseyside, Liverpool. The above Martin Brennan died 7 th April 1996 aged 80.
Brennan(3)	7	(Upright tomb stone behind Wallace and close to Richard Nail) Erected by Mary Brennan in memory of her husband Thomas who died 28 th May 1802 aged 66. Also two of his sons Laurence and Joseph.
Brennan (4)	8	(Upright tomb stone with medallion and instruments of the Passion on top.) Here lieth ye body of John Brennan who died November 20 th 1772 aged 52 years.
Brown (1)	9	(Small upright tomb stone with round top between Michael Davis and MI. Walsh.) Erected by Richard Brown of Kilree in memory of his father John Brown also his mother Julia Brown (no dates given).
Brown (2)	10	(Small upright beside Richard Lahey and Patrick Kerivan) Here lieth the body of Laurence Brown and his daughter Joan. She died 19 th January 1774 aged 19 years.
Butler (1)	11	(Small upright between William McCarthy and James Corcoran, rather worn.) Erected by Richard Butler of Barestown (? Brabstown) in memory of his father Thomas Butler who died November 4 th 1812 aged 98, his mother Mary Butler alias Walsh died November 1 st 1814 aged 61 years. Also above Richard died 28 th June 1852 aged 70 and his wife Elizabeth (Eliza

		Maher) died 27 th September 1871 aged 90 years.
Butler (2)	11 _b	Erected by John Butler in memory of his wife Mary Butler who died in 1775 aged 29 years and of his son Thomas Butler who died in 1801 aged 27 years. Also his daughter Catherine who died in December 1801 aged 32 years.
Cahill (1)	12	(Small upright leaning back between Pk. Ryan and Ml. Davis.) D.O.M. God be merciful to the soul of William Cahill who died in the year 1763 aged 60. Also his son Jno Cahill died September 1782 aged 40 years.
Cahill (2)	14	(Small rounded upright between John Fahy and Pierce Baron) In memory of James Cahill, Kilree who died 17 th July 1881 aged 76 years.
Callanan	15	(New grave slab between James Maher and Dan McDonald, tower side) In memory of Hanora Callanan who died 26 th May 1905 and her husband Michael who died 15 th March 1957 Tomb maker – Mullan, Kilkenny
Carthy	17	(Large upright between Stephens and Patrick Lawlor) Erected by Patrick Carthy of Kilree in memory of his father Timothy Carthy who died March 16 th 1818 aged 62. Also his mother Honoria Carthy who died November 13 th 1837 aged 60. Also his brother John Carthy who died May 7 th 1854 aged 30.
Carty	19	(Under Yew tree and between Widow Brennan and William McCarthy) Erected by Charles Carty of Rahallikin in memory of his daughter Mary Carty who died March 15 th 1808 aged 26 years.
Clooney	20	(Small upright behind East windows of Church) Erected by Thomas Clooney in memory of his son Michael Clooney who died November 10 th 1824 aged 25 years.
Collier	23	(Large Altar tomb next to church wall, under ivy covered palm tree, very difficult to read) The Revd. Thomas Collier, Rector of Listerlin is here interred having departed 30 th day of October 1763 in the ----- year of his age. Note: Rector of Ballytarsney 1753 and Listerlin 1762. Son of Enoch Collier, Tabernarius. (see Leslie, 1933)
Comerford (1)	24	(This magnificent altar tomb which stands in the North-West corner of the Chancel (under window) is the finest monument here. The covering slab has a raised 8 pointed floriated cross with interlaced bands in the centre i.e. the fretty of the St. Legers, beneath this are representations of the sun and moon symbols used in connection with the Passion of Our Lord. Inscription, in Latin, on raised border reads: "Hic jacet Dominus Richardus Comerford" etc. Translation – Here lie Mr Richard Comerford formerly of Danganmore who died ---- (no date) and the Lady Joanna St. Leger his wife, a matron pious, hospitable and charitable to all, who died October 4 th 1622. Note: Both Richard Comerford and his wife Joanna are also commemorated on the plinth of a Cross at the entrance to Danganmore bosheen. See R. Larhart " <i>History of the Parish of Dunnamaggan</i> ".

Comerford (2)	24 _b	Erected by Patrick Comerford in memory of his father James Comerford who departed this life March 10 th 1789 aged 80 years. May he rest in peace.
Corcoran (1)	25	(Behind Butler, McCarthy and Carty) Erected by James Corcoran of Lamonstown in memory of his father Michael Corcoran who died 6 th April 1810 aged 55. Also his daughter Mary Corcoran who died 12 th May 1827 aged - 6? years.
Corcoran (2) / Corkoran	26	(Beside above, under tree) Erected by Patrick Corkoran of Lemonstown in memory of his son John who died 17 th March 1814 aged 6 years, also his father John Corkoran who died 19 th July 1814 aged 67 years.
Davis (1)	29	(Celtic cross with shamrock on shaft between Mgt Phelan & Thos. Barry) Erected as a tribute of love by his children to the memory of James Davis, Tinvawn who died 28 th June 1882 aged 85. His wife Margaret died 19 th April 1892 aged 85 and his sister Catherine died 9 th Feb 1894 aged 95. R.I.P. Recent Burial: James Davis died 3 rd January 1953 aged 73. His wife Mary died 11 th November 1957 aged 67. Richard Davis died 26 th January 1963 aged 79. N--- Davis died 5 th December 1971 aged 87. Tomb maker – Hoban, Kilkenny
Davis (2)	30	(Tall upright with circled cross at top. Between William Cahill and Richard Brown) Erected by Michael Davis, Danganmore in memory of his mother Mary Davis who died 13 th March 1886 aged 68 (or 63). His father Thomas Davis died 19 th May 1895 aged 80. The above Michael Davis died 31 st Jan. 1939 aged 82. Tomb maker – O'Shea, Kilkenny
Deady	31	(Large Celtic Cross with five bosses. Next to Pollard Altar tomb) Sacred to the memory of Mary Anne the beloved wife of Michael Deady of Jerpoint Abbey who died 22 nd June 1879 and Kate M. Quinlan for 32 years the beloved wife of William Deady who died February 1913. Also the said William who died 29 th April 1914 aged 66. R.I.P.
Deloughry (1)	33	(Small upright to left of Mrs Catherine Purcell) Erected by John Deloughry of Tinvane in memory of his daughter Mary who died December 4 th 1828 aged 18 years. Also of his daughter Johanna who died January 7 th 1829 aged 15 years, and his daughter Bridget who died March 20 th 1829 aged 11 years.
Fahy (1)	40	(Large round top upright between Robinson and Fahy) Erected by James Fahy of Kilree in memory of his wife Anastasia alias Durney who died March 18 th 1818 aged 50 years. Eleanor Fahy his mother died March 6 th 1816 aged 87 years and her daughter Anty Fahy who died young.
Fahy (2)	41	(Large upright, triangular top, close to Fahy (1), well kept grave)

		<p>Erected in memory of John Fahy for 28 years the strictly honest and truly faithful Steward of Thomas Shaw of Kilree. He departed this life 11th February 1859 in the 69th year of his aged and 56th year of his service in Kilree.</p> <p>Attached to this headstone and in the same plot:: James Cahill died 24th June 1932 aged 45. His wife Ellen died 9th Jan. 1958 aged 71 years. His parents Mary Cahill died 24th April 1912 aged 64, Patrick died 17th April 1921 aged 80 years. His son Thomas died 11th April 1929 aged 5 months and daughter May died 6th April 1930 aged 13.</p>
Fennelly	42	<p>(Celtic Cross opposite entrance gate)</p> <p>Erected by John and Michael Fennelly of Oldtown in memory of their father Patrick Fennelly who died 30th December 1874 aged 55. Also their mother who died 19th May 1901 aged 66. Also Michael Fennelly of Ballycaum who died August 30th 1957 aged 81 and his wife Ellen died May 9th 1961 aged 83.</p> <p>On side of Cross – And their son Patrick who died in U.S.A. 21st January 1957. Also two brothers who died young.</p> <p>Tomb maker – Foley, Grovine.</p>
Fleming	43	<p>(Inside Church to right of entrance. Celtic Cross in white marble)</p> <p>Erected by Pierce Fleming in memory of his beloved wife Bridget nee Hanrahan who died 30th August 1914 aged 65 and his daughter Bridget Mary who died young.</p> <p>Tomb maker – Molloy, Callan</p>
Foote	45	<p>(Small upright level with West end of Church. Near Kerivan, worn.)</p> <p>Here lyes ye body of James Foote, he died 4th April 1759 aged 33. ----Falce Foote, ----- Richard and Robert Foote, ----- .</p>
Gorey	46	<p>(Celtic Cross inside Church, at foot of Comerford / St. Leger tomb)</p> <p>“In loving memory of Daniel Gorey, Killiney, Kells” who died December 9th 1919 and his wife Catherine who died February 19th 1928. Also their son Denis John Gorey T.D. Burnchurch who died February 19th 1940 and his daughter Elizabeth Mary who died August 4th 1931.</p> <p>Tomb maker – Gargan.</p>
Hanrahan	47	<p>Erected to the memory of Mrs Julia Hanrahan of Goodwins Garden who died 3rd Sept. 1887 aged 68 years. Also her son Patrick Hanrahan who died 29th July 1817 aged 21 years.</p>
Holohan (1)	49	<p>(Upright close to tree and Corkoran)</p> <p>Erected by Ann Holohan alias Culleton of Cottrelsrath in memory of her husband Michael Holohan who died October 7th 1830 aged 73 and her daughter Mary Holohan who died November 22nd 1836 aged 33. Also five children who died young.</p>
Holohan (2) / Houlahan	50	<p>(Upright next to Church wall and near Revd Thomas Collier)</p> <p>Erected by Thomas Houlahan in memory of his daughter Catherine Houlahan who died 6th December 1793 aged 20 years, R.I.P. Also his grandson Richard Houlahan who died December 24th 1793 aged 4 years. The above Thomas Houlahan died April 18th 1800 aged 77. Also his daughter Elizabeth who died July 9th 1816 aged 52.</p>

Holohan (3)	51	(Close to above, an upright tomb stone with crucifixion carving) Erected by Richard Holohan, Cottrelsrath in memory of his mother Mrs Margaret Holohan alias Izod who died July 16 th 1819 aged 80. Also his son Richard Holohan who died March 26 th 1832 aged 20 and his son Thomas died July 5 th 1833 aged 28. Note: For more Holohans (Knocktopher) see Inscription for Beal Borr by M.M. Phelan and M. Buggy.
Holden	52	(Incised Floriated Cross broken in 3 parts lies in the NE angle of the Church. Inscription starts at North wall side. We were unable to read this but Richard Lahart in his book on "Dunnamaggan" describes it very well and gives the inscription as follows: <i>I.H.S. Hic jacet Thomas Howling quod (quondam) DNS (Dominus) de Kilre A.D. cccccxxx IIII. XI Die mes (mensis) Maii. -- Translation: Here lies Thomas Holden Lord of Kilree, died 11th day of May A.D. 1534.</i>
Izod (1)	53	(High Altar tomb inside Church, much broken, with classical panelling and upright in 18 th century manner). Here lie the mortal remains of Darkey, beloved wife of William Izod of Chapel Izod in this County. She died June 10 th 1834. "Her loss will be long regretted. She was ever attending to the needs of the poor".
Izod (2)	54	(At the foot of Izod (1) and in good condition about a foot high – a tomb with raised four pointed cross – in the medieval manner, but more clumsily and thickly cut is the inscription:-) "In memory of Lorenzo Nickson Izod Esq. of Chapel Izod in this County. Born June 4 th 1812. Died February 4 th 1884. Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his Saints". On the top and on each side of the cross is a later inscription:- "Also to the memory of Elizabeth Catherine Izod beloved wife of Lorenzo N. Izod Esq. who died 28 th day of April 1908 aged 89 years."
Izod (3)	55	(A plain Altar tomb against south wall of Chance. Very clear cutting but moss covered) "Elizabeth Waring otherwise Izod wife of William Izod of Chapel Izod in this County who departed this life 24 th day of Jan 1770 in the 48 th year of her age. Here also the above named William died 15 th Feb. 1789 in the 82 nd year of his age having continued a widower 19 years lamenting the loss of a good and tender wife". Note: Hugh Waring was Sheriff of Kilkenny 1801 -1802
Johnson	58	(Sarcophagus with Latin cross down centre, near east corner of south wall.) In loving memory of Edith Harriett beloved wife of Evans C. Johnson Esq. M.C.S., and daughter of Lorenzo and Elizabeth of Capelizod House. Born Feb 7 th 1848. Died Nov. 6 th 1900. Note: See St Kierans Church Yard, Kells.
Keane	59	Erected by Michael Keane in memory of his wife Bridget Keane alias Comerford who departed this life 19 th March 1807 aged 52 years. Also Denis Keane and his wife Mary Keane alias Keefe, he died 15 th January 1787 aged 85 years and she December 15 th 1774 aged 66 years with two

		of their grandsons. May they rest in peace.
Keeffe	60	(Large upright between Richard Neil and John Brennan). Erected by James Keeffe in memory of his father Pierce Keeffe who died September 28 th 1794 aged 53, of his mother Eliza Keeffe alias Egan who died June 17 th 1803 aged 66, of his sister Anstas Neile alias Keeffe who died Dec 20 th 1815 aged 40. Note: Keeffes still live at Westbank House (1972).
Kerivan	61	(Large upright between Laurence Brown and James Foote) Erected by Patrick Kerivan in memory of his father Thomas Kerivan who died May 16 th 1801 aged 58.
Lahy	62	(Small upright near Laurence Brown and close to Church wall) Erected by Richard Lahy in memory of his wife Catherine Lahy alias Meala. She died November 15 th 1791 aged 73 years, with three of her children, R.I.P.
Lannon	65	(Small upright between Michael Walsh & John Robinson). Here lieth the body of James Lannon who departed this life December 25 th 1773 aged 34.
Lawler	66	(Upright with cross on top and W. Lawlor in large letters at foot. Close to yew tree between Partick Carthy and James Maher. Tower side). Sacred to the memory of Patrick Lawler, Kilree who died 27 th May 1887 aged 82, also his wife Ellen Lawler died 12 th April 1870 aged 64. His nephew James Lawler died April 12 th 1903 aged 20. Their son James Lawler who died in America on 4 th April 1891 aged 44. R.I.P. Tomb maker – Gargan.
McCarthy	67	(Small tombstone leaning forward between Carty and Butler) Here lies the body of William McCarthy who died Sept 18 th 1739 aged 70. Also the body of his wife Anstice McCarthy alias Lahey who died Oct 13 th 1742 aged 63 and two children ----- (more underground)
McDonald	68	(Small round-top slab close to Callanan. Tower side.) In memory of Danl. McDonald who died 23 rd August 1922 aged 50.
Maher	69	(Large upright next to Lawler and under Yew tree. Tower side.) Erected by James Maher of High Street, Kilkenny in memory of his beloved brother John Maher who died March 26 th 1819 aged 30 years.
Meighan	74	(Square slab close to Pierce Baron and Richard Tobin, Kells. I.H.S.) In loving memory of Elizabeth Meighan E.N.T. Kells who died 13 th August 1944. Her husband Meighan died 24 th October 1908 and Mary Ann Meighan died 31 st October 1947. Margaret Meighan died 7 th January 1970. R.I.P. Tomb maker – Molloy, Callan
Merriman	75	(Small upright near Adams to right of Church entrance.) William Merriman ex Constable R.I.C. died December 6 th 1918 aged 68, also his wife Ellen Merriman died 31 st December 1921 aged 68. Tomb maker – Gargan.

Nale	77	(Upright leaning back and slightly under Neale) Erected by Richard Nale of Kilkenny in memory of his father Michael Nale who died April 20 th 1814 aged 58. Also his brother David who died 29 th April 1826 aged 28 years.
Nail	78	(Upright leaning forward between Brennan and Neill) God be merciful to the soul of Richard Nail who died 1 st March 1780 aged 29.
Neale	79	(Large upright slightly overlapping Nale) Erected by Mary Neale alias Hearn in memory of her husband Patrick Neale who died 15 th August 1809 aged 54, also their son William who died Nov 5 th 1809 aged 25 years. R.I.P.
Neill	81	(Upright now leaning forward between Nail and Neale) Erected by James Neill of Kilkenny in memory of his son John Neill who died April 5 th 1824 aged 30.
Pendergast	84	(Upright to left of Robinson, Latin Cross) Erected by Mary Pendergast alias Clancy in memory of her husband Thomas Pendergast of Kells who died February 2 nd 1833 aged 46 years also one of their children Hanna Prendergast who died February 4 th 1835 aged 18 months, also his son James Pendergast who died May 16 th 1830 aged 16 years.
Phelan (1)	85	(Celtic Cross with Sacred Heart on white marble. Between Thos.Barry & Widow Phelan) Erected by Patrick Phelan of Newchurch in memory of his mother Hanora nee Shortall who died March 5 th 1872 aged 70. His father John Phelan died July 19 th 1876 aged 70. His daughter Margaret died Sept 10 th 1879 aged 14 years. His sons - John died Jan 28 th 1886 aged 24 years, and Rev. Michael Phelan died July 30 th 1894 aged 27 years, and Thomas died Oct 27 th 1898 aged 32 years. His wife Elizabeth nee Walsh died Mar 12 th 1915 aged 87. On side of Cross – Patrick Phelan died 26 th March 1918 aged 85, his daughter Elizabeth Morris died 17 th October 1916 aged 45. Also sons - Daniel died 20 th September 1933 aged 75 and James died 14 th Feb 1938 aged 66. Also his daughter Mary Brennan died 11 th March 1939 aged 80 years. R.I.P. Tomb maker – Molloy, Callan.
Phelan (2)	86	(Upright to left of Phelan (1)) Erected by the Widow Phelan alias Walsh in memory of her husband Patrick Phelan who died March 31 st 1823 aged 64. Also his daughter Mary Shortall alias Phelan who died February 12 th 1837 aged 24 years.
Phelan (3)	87	(Small upright, D.O.M. between Walter Walsh & James Davis) Here lies the body of Margaret Phelan daughter of David & Margaret Phelan. She died 12 th February 1779 aged 18 years. R.I.P.
Pollard	89	(Altar tomb next to Deady Celtic Cross) Underneath lie the remains of William Pollard of Kilree who died March

		22 nd 1821 aged --2 years. Also his mother Mrs Mary Pollard alias Deloughry who died April 1 st 1832 aged 92 years. Also his third son Edmond who died 18 th April 1831 aged 17 years. Also his eldest son John died June 21 st 1835 aged 25 years. Also his wife Mary Pollard alias Power who died April 15 th 1816 aged 67. Also his sister Mary Pollard of Kells who died August 9 th 1817 aged 68 years. Also Mrs Nano Pollard, Olmstead Falls, Ohio, America who died at Jerpoint January 1 st 1874 aged 56 years.
Purcell (1)	92	(Large upright close to Widow Brennan) Erected by James Purcell in memory of his daughter Mary Ryan alias Purcell who died February 16 th 1814 aged 24 years. Also his son James who died October 27 th 1817 aged 13 years.
Purcell (2)	93	(High upright to left of railed in cross which has fallen forward) Erected by Mrs Catherine Purcell alias Martin of the City of Kilkenny in memory of her husband Mr John Purcell who departed this life Nov. 4 th 1832 in the 35 th year of his age. Also two of their children Dennis and Anastatia who died young.
Purcell (3)	94	Erected by Bridget Purcell, Patrick Street, Kilkenny in memory of her father Denis Purcell who died at Ladywell, Feb 9 th 1837 aged 65 years, and her mother Anastatia Purcell who died 19 th July 1854 aged 68 (78?), and in memory of her who erected this monument. Also her sister Catherine.
Robinson (1)	95	(Limestone Latin cross between Walshe & Pendergast) Erected by Mary Celia Robinson of Kells in memory of her husband John Robinson who died 11 th October 1924 aged 64 years. R.I.P.
Robinson (2)	96	(Small slab with Maltese Cross on top between Bannon and Fahy) A tribute of remembrance by his sister Lizzie to John Robinson, born at Bagenalstown 11 th April 1869 and died at Kells 11 th October 1924. R.I.P.
Ryan	97	(Small upright leaning back between Shee and Cahill) Here lieth the bodys of Patrick Ryan and his wife Hanna Delany. Also Richard Ryan who died 6 th June 1770 aged 25 years. Erected by John Ryan his father.
Shee / O'Shea	100	(Upright, tall and well cut. Between Pendergast & Ryan) Erected by Michael Shee in memory of his daughter Mary Shee who died 25 th Feb 1812 aged 26. Later inscription: William O'Shea, Dunnamaggin died 14 th May 1895 aged 92 years, and his wife Bridget O'Shea nee Coady died 27 th May 1902 aged 84.
Stephens	103	(Tall upright with reclining lamb next north wall of Church) Erected by Anne Stephens in memory of her father John Stephens, Kilree who died 9 th April 1881 aged 86 (83?). Also her mother Catherine Stephens who died 11 th June 1862 aged 60. Also her brother John died 1 st May 1862 aged 27. Also Patrick who died February 7 th 1866 aged 63 years.
Tobin (1)	105	(Celtic Cross. "Tobin" engraved on surround. Close to Meighan.) In loving memory of Richard Tobin, Kells who died November 14 th 1938 and his beloved wife Norah Tobin alias Barry who died August 8 th 1942.
