**Foreword:** by M. Buggy

Outrath, Rath Uachter – meaning upper rath. The ancient Church now completely destroyed was called Teampall Ratha Uachtair. The travelling fraternity hold burial rights in this Cemetery. A medieval dwelling in ruins north of the cemetery is believed to have been a Rothe family house (O' Kelly, 1953).

The Cemetery is triangular in shape, has an entrance gate and two stiles. It contains many readable tombstones, others lie face down or underneath the ground surface and are therefore unread. We found one Priest's burial place here – the Revd. Father Thadee Gready who died in 1756. The oldest tombstone found was dated 1710.

Erected by Mrs Kate Blanchfield in memory of her father Thomas Egan who died October 3 <sup>rd</sup> 1911, also his wife Johanna died 21 <sup>st</sup> April 1908 and their son John Egan died 23 <sup>rd</sup> January 1922.
Buckley	7	(Small upright tombstone between James Delahunty and John Mackey.) God be merciful to the soul of John Buckley who died 2 <sup>nd</sup> September ----- aged 34 and children.
Butler	9	(Celtic Cross near Yew tree and Mackey) Sacred to the memory of Tobias Butler of Sheastown who died July 4 <sup>th</sup> 1907 aged 80, and his wife Catherine who died October 30 <sup>th</sup> 1920 aged 74, also their son Thomas died March 18 <sup>th</sup> 1904 aged 23 and daughter Bridget died January 20 <sup>th</sup> 1913 aged 30. Tomb maker - Gargan
Cantwell	12	(Upright tombstone between Corbet and Thomas Walshe's altar tomb) Erected by Thomas Cantwell, Outrath in memory of his father James Cantwell who died ----- March ----- aged 67. (date obliterated)
Carroll	13	(Tombstone leaning forward, end corner of Cemetery) Catherine Carroll alias Kenane died January 6 <sup>th</sup> 1782 aged 72. Erected by Davey and Michael, her sons.
Clear	14	(Between Ruth and Michael Leahy, beside path) Erected by Mr Thomas Clear of Kilkenny in memory of three children, died young, here also lie the remains of his father the above Thomas who died July 22 <sup>nd</sup> 1827. Note: According to Pigot's Directory for 1824 Thomas Clear of Rose Inn Street was a Publican.
Comerford	16	(Small upright tombstone behind the Hickey family). Here lieth the body of Catherine Comerford who departed this life March 5 <sup>th</sup> 1776.
Corbett	19	(Large leaning tombstone between Denis Doran and Thomas Cantwell) Erected by Elinor Corbett alias Doran in memory of her husband John Corbett of Loughboy who died March 8 <sup>th</sup> 1857 aged 65 and three children who died young.
Costelloe (1)	20	(Upright tombstone between Mary Martin and Patrick Costelloe of Wallslough.) Erected by Patrick Costelloe of Wallslough in memory of his father James Costelloe who died June 10 <sup>th</sup> 1849 aged 75, also his mother Margaret Costelloe alias Power died September 17 <sup>th</sup> 1840 aged 68. Andrew Costelloe of Newtown died June 18 <sup>th</sup> 1870. William Costelloe of Wallslough died November 10 <sup>th</sup> 1844 aged 84. Mrs Costello alias Fennelly died April 15 <sup>th</sup> 1827 aged 56. William Costelloe died 17 <sup>th</sup> April 1905 aged 85. Mrs William Costelloe of Newtown died March 1 <sup>st</sup> 1914 and William Costelloe of Newtown died March 22 <sup>nd</sup> 1922 aged 81.
Costelloe (2)	21	(Upright tombstone between Costelloe (1) and James Purtel) Erected by Patrick Costelloe of Wallslough in memory of his wife Sarah

		Costelloe alias Houlihan who died January 10 <sup>th</sup> 1802 aged 70. Also Mrs Patrick Costelloe who died June 13 <sup>th</sup> 1882 aged 65. Patrick Costelloe died February 12 <sup>th</sup> 1900 aged 90 years.
Croak	23	(Between Farrell and Curley – near small stile) Erected by Pierce Croak in memory of his father Nicholas Croak and mother Catherine Croak alias Bowden. Also son James died August 1811 aged 10 years and wife Anne Croak alias Comerford died 16 <sup>th</sup> February 1847 aged 42.
Curley	25	(Small upright tombstone between Croak and Walsh). Here lies the body of John Curley who died 6 <sup>th</sup> May 1795 aged 28.
Delahunty (1)	27	(Upright tombstone behind Somers and in front of Ryan) Sacred to the memory of Thomas Delahunty who died January 2 <sup>nd</sup> 1813 aged 8 years. Here also are the remains of Mr. James Rooth of Kilfera who died March 2 <sup>nd</sup> 1766 aged 50 years. Also the body of Mrs Anastasia Rooth alias Colby wife of the above James Rooth who died 3 <sup>rd</sup> August 1794.
Delahunty (2)	28	(Upright tombstone between Sheehan and Buckley) Erected by James Delahunty in memory of his mother Anastatia Delahunty alias Lawless who died 7 <sup>th</sup> October, 1798 aged 42, also her father Sylvester Lawless of Sheestown who died April 20 <sup>th</sup> 1781 and her mother Mary Lawless alias Cahill who died April 10 <sup>th</sup> 1777 aged 67 years.
Dobbyn	29	(Small upright, very worn, date underground). Here lyes ye body of Anna Kenny wife to Nicholas Dobbyn -----
Doheny	30	(Starting left to right from boundary fence to road. Beside Mulroney). Erected by Mrs Bridget Doheny in memory of her husband Michael Doheny who died 8 <sup>th</sup> January 1865 aged 60, also two children John and Joseph died young. The above Bridget Doheny died July 7 <sup>th</sup> 1903 aged 75. R.I.P.
Doyle (1)	32	(Altar tomb - ivy covered) In memory of Arthur Doyle who departed this life in his 56 <sup>th</sup> year on 6 <sup>th</sup> July 1811 at his residence Cloth Hall, Waterford. In him were combined love of country ----- Here also repose his revered mother Frances Doyle alias Byrne who died 8 <sup>th</sup> July 1836 in the 81 <sup>st</sup> year of her age R.I.P. Note: Taken from Pigots Directory 1824 – Arthur Doyle & Co., Woollen Drapers, Cloth Hall, Michael St., Waterford. [See Doyle(3) Danesfort]
Doyle (2)	33	(Upright tombstone between William Mackay and Mary Ann McDonald). This monument was erected by Tobias Doyle late of Kilcreen in memory of his wife Bridget Doyle alias Daly who died July 5 <sup>th</sup> 1786 aged 32.
Doyle (3)	35	(Altar tomb between Patrick Mulroney and William Sweeny). Here lieth the body of Arthur Doyle son of Terence Doyle of Danesfort who died ye ----- November 1761 aged 24 and brothers Michael and Walter Doyle. R.I.P. Note: See Doyle (1), Waterford

Doran	34	(Small tombstone near Shelly and the large leaning tombstone of Corbett). Erected by Denis Doran in memory of his son Mr John Doran of Outrath who died August 13 <sup>th</sup> 1809 ----- .
Eagan	38	(Upright tombstone between Mackey and Meighan) Erected by Patrick Eagan in memory of his son James who died September 13 <sup>th</sup> 1793 aged 25, also his daughter Mary R.I.P. Also body of John Eagan who died March 1797 aged 24 also his son John Eagan who died 25 <sup>th</sup> February 1833 aged 28.
Eardley (1)	40	(Inside and to left of small stile. Iron cross and tombstone in same well cared for plot). In loving memory of Michael Eardley of Outrath who lost his life October 1 <sup>st</sup> 1928 aged 15.
Eardley (2)	41	In loving memory of Kate Eardley, Outrath who died November 4 <sup>th</sup> 1946 aged 70, her son Michael died October 1 <sup>st</sup> 1928 aged 15. Also her husband John Eardley died January 9 <sup>th</sup> 1948 aged 80. Erected by their loving family. R.I.P. Tomb maker - Gargan Note: Eardley name rare here, originally from Mooncoin.
Farrell	42	(Close to tombstone of Matt Murphy (lying flat)) Erected by Margaret Farrell of the City of Kilkenny in memory of her beloved daughter Miss Mary Farrell who died February 1830 aged 22.
Glynn	48	(Upright tombstone close to Marking Stone of Myles and Kelly) Erected by Mary Glynn of Walkin Street, Kilkenny in memory of her husband Patrick Glynn who died 25 <sup>th</sup> May 1880 aged 53. Also two children died young. Also her mother Statia Lalor died March 10 <sup>th</sup> 1889 aged 70. Above Mary Glynn died March 15 <sup>th</sup> 1908 aged 66. (Plaque for Moore on Glynn grave – see Moore)
Gready (1)	50	(Small upright tombstone facing East near Laffans and at rear of Cemetery). God be merciful to ye Soul of ye Revd. Father Thadee Gready deceased ye 1 <sup>st</sup> December 1756 aged 70 years. Also of the souls of his parents and relatives. R.I.P. Note: The only Priest's grave found here. Greadys also found in Tullamaine.
Gready (2)	51	(Upright tombstone facing Father Gready) D.O.M. God be merciful to the Soul of Richard Gready who died March 20 <sup>th</sup> 1783 aged 79. Also the body of John Gready his son.
Harris	52	(Close to Eardley and Meehan). Here lyes the body of Margaret Harris, alias Kinahan and Mary Foley alias Harris who died 17 <sup>th</sup> June 1767 aged 45 with many of their children who died young.
Heffernan	53	(Between Dobbyn-Kenny and Muldowney) Erected by Dennis Heffernan of Bishops Hill in memory of his father John

		Heffernan who died 28 <sup>th</sup> ----- 1799 aged 60. Also his mother Mary Heffernan alias Comerford who died September 1806 aged 62. Note: According to Pigots Directory 1824 a John Heffernan, Publican, lived in Vicar Street, Kilkenny.
Hickey (1)	56	(Celtic cross, one of three in a row close to the end ditch). This Celtic cross has been erected to the memory of Thomas Hickey late of 62 High Street, Kilkenny who died 7 <sup>th</sup> October 1929 aged 72, second son of Thomas and Margaret Hickey who are also interred here. Also his sister Nora who died September 25 <sup>th</sup> 1931 aged 60, and brother James died July 28 <sup>th</sup> 1928 aged 79. Also a sister Anastatia died 8 <sup>th</sup> February 1948 aged 84. Tomb maker - Gargan, Kilkenny
Hickey (2)	57	(High upright tombstone with cross on top). Erected by Mary Hickey of James Street, Kilkenny City in memory of her beloved husband Joseph Hickey who died June 1 <sup>st</sup> 1882 aged 43. Three children, John two months, Mary Agnes died April 8 <sup>th</sup> 1886 aged 12 years. Teresa died December 12 <sup>th</sup> 1919 aged 38. Also Mrs Mary Hickey nee Mulrooney, Outrath died August 31 <sup>st</sup> 1839 and six children died young. The above Mary Hickey died October 5 <sup>th</sup> 1927 aged 80 and her son Joseph died January 20 <sup>th</sup> 1939 aged 56.
Hickey (3)	58	(Smaller upright with cross on top). Erected in fond memory of Thomas Hickey 64 High Street who died 4 <sup>th</sup> August 1871 and his beloved wife Margaret who died December 3 <sup>rd</sup> 1891, also their youngest son Joseph Patrick died 22 <sup>nd</sup> August 1916. R.I.P.
Ivory	62	(Upright tombstone near Hickeys). Erected by Mary Ivory alias Mackay in memory of her husband James Ivory who died 10 <sup>th</sup> December 1793 aged 30. Also his father Daniel Ivory died in December 1789 aged 80. Also 3 of James Ivory's children. Also the body of Brigid Ivory who died 9 <sup>th</sup> February 1811 aged 48. Note: Pigots Directory 1824 gives a Patrick Ivory, High Street, Linen & Draper.
Johnson (1)	63	(Iron Cross on blue concrete base) In loving memory of Mary Johnson who died 9 <sup>th</sup> January 1924.
Johnson (2)	64	(Beside above and between Lee and Butler of Sheastown. Near yew tree). In loving memory of Thomas Johnson, Dominic Street, Kilkenny who died 8 <sup>th</sup> November, 1965. His mother Mary died 9 <sup>th</sup> January 1924. Erected by his loving wife. Tomb maker - Walsh, Carlow
Kelly	65	(Large upright tombstone between Glynn and Mulroney) Erected by James Kelly of James Green in memory of his beloved wife Alice who died January 10 <sup>th</sup> 1873 aged 36 and 4 children died young. Also his father James Kelly, his mother Margaret Kelly, and brother Thomas. In your charity pray for their repose. The above James Kelly died January 3 <sup>rd</sup> 1886 aged 48. R.I.P.
Laffan (1)	70	(From left to right (rear of Cemetery) four upright tombstones for Laffans in same line.)

		Erected by Mrs Margaret Laffan of City of Kilkenny in memory of her husband Mr Henry Laffan who died 26 <sup>th</sup> September 1815 aged 57. Note: Pigots Directory 1824 gives a Margaret Laffan, Publican, Walkin Street.
Laffan (2)	71	Erected by Mrs Judith Laffan alias Fennelly of City of Kilkenny, in memory of her husband Mr Matthew Laffan who died June 22 <sup>nd</sup> 1805 aged 55.
Laffan (3)	72	Erected by Thomas Laffan in memory of his father and mother, Henry Laffan and Mary Laffan alias Hoban. He died June 1800 aged 62. She died May 1799 aged 50. As also 16 of their children with 3 of said Thomas Laffans. Eliza Murphy alias Laffan his daughter died 14 <sup>th</sup> June 1867 aged 47.
Laffan (4)	73	Here lieth the body of Thomas Laffan who died April 22 <sup>nd</sup> 1763 aged 50. Also his daughter Catherine Laffan who died December 18 <sup>th</sup> 1762 aged 14 years with 5 more children. Also the body of his brother Matthew who died February 1 <sup>st</sup> 1762 aged 24 years. Erected by Matthew Laffan, son.
Lanagan	75	(Small upright tombstone close to and facing Rev. Thadee Gready.) Here lies the body of Daniel Lanagan who died January 1772. Also 5 of his children. R.I.P.
Leahy (1)	78	(Upright between Walsh and Manning, near gate.) Of your charity pray for the repose of the soul of Mr William Leahy of High Street, Kilkenny City who died 8 <sup>th</sup> September 1858 at the premature age of 38 years. Also his beloved wife Anne Leahy alias Walsh died 21 <sup>st</sup> July 1857 aged 28 years.
Leahy (2)	80	(Altar tomb between Clear and Baldwin, close to path.) Erected by Michael Leahy, Vicar Street, City of Kilkenny in memory of his beloved father Mr Patrick Leahy who died April 18 <sup>th</sup> 1869 aged 66. His mother Mrs Mary Leahy alias McGrath died January 12 <sup>th</sup> 1861 aged 51 and 5 children died young.
Lee	81	(Nearest stile, upright slanting tombstone.) In loving memory of Mrs Mary Lee who died 1866 aged 38 and her husband John Lee who died 1872 aged 51. Also their son Robert Lee died 1864 aged 9. Stone erected by their loving sons Joseph, Thomas and John Lee.
Mackay (1)	82	(Small upright between Muldowney and Ryan) Erected by Edmund Mackay in memory of his daughter Anastatia who died February 14 <sup>th</sup> 1830.
Mackay (2)	83	(Upright between Ivory and Doyle) Here lies the body of William Mackay who died March 17 <sup>th</sup> 1742 aged 56. Also his wife Mary Mackay alias Marshil who died January 1787 aged 72. R.I.P. Erected by their Children Margaret and ----- Mackay.
Mackey (4)	85	(Upright between Buckley and Eagan)

		Erected by John Mackey in memory of his wife Catherine alias Quigley who died 2 <sup>nd</sup> March 1803 aged 66 and four children.
Mackey (5)	86	(Between Hickey and altar tomb of Michael Alexander Mac Donald) Erected by Joseph Mackey in memory of his father Patrick Mackey of Newtown who departed this life August 2 <sup>nd</sup> 1816 aged 87. Also of his mother Anastatia Mackey alias Cuddahy who departed April 23 <sup>rd</sup> 1847 aged 85.
Manning	87	(Upright Celtic cross (now broken off) between Leahy and Ryan). Erected by Thomas Manning of High Street to the memory of his dear wife Mary Ellen Josephine Manning alias Walsh who died 20 <sup>th</sup> August 1882 aged 26. Note: Above Thomas Manning had a licensed spirit & grocery, seeds etc. at No 8 High Street, (now Lawlors). He was grandfather of travel agent Des Manning. M. E. Josephine was his first wife and died on the birth of her daughter Alice who died young.
Martin (1)	88	(To left of entrance gate facing boundary fence, beside Somers.) Here lieth the body of Pierce Martin who died November 7 <sup>th</sup> 1770 aged 47. R.I.P. Erected by his wife Mary alias Waton (Walton?).
Martin (2)	89	(Close to above, leaning forward.) Here lies ye body of Pierce Martin who died April 7 <sup>th</sup> 1710 aged 29. His son Michael died March 30 <sup>th</sup> 1720 aged 20 years. Note: This appears to be the oldest tombstone found at Outrath.
Martin (3)	90	(Beside above.) Erected to the memory of Mrs Mary Martin alias Barrett of Johns Green who died Dec 17 <sup>th</sup> 1821 aged 52, and four children died young. Also her daughter Mrs Margaret Butler alias Martin died June 24 <sup>th</sup> 1828 aged 30. Also the remains of Mr. John Barrett, New Barracks ----- . (Rest difficult to read)
Meehan (1)	92	(Left corner facing boundary ditch between O'Brien and Somers. Near entrance gate.) Erected by James Meehan, Loughboy in memory of his mother Ellen Meehan who died 29 <sup>th</sup> February 1922 and his brother William died 6 <sup>th</sup> August 1946.
Meehan (2)	93	Marking stone – small next to James Purtel. Meehan. Tomb maker - Walsh, Carlow.
Meehan (3)	94	(Iron Cross beside above and near Cypress Tree) In loving memory of Mrs Mary Meehan who died February 22 <sup>nd</sup> 1930.
Meehan (4)	95	(Beside Harris near small stile.) Erected by Richard Meehan, Dublin late of John Street Kilkenny in memory of his brother John who died September 3 <sup>rd</sup> 1898 aged 23. Also his father Patrick Meehan who died November 1 <sup>st</sup> 1908 aged 68 and his niece Beatrice Garvey died July 7 <sup>th</sup> 1913 aged 7 months. Also his mother Anne

		Meehan died November 3 <sup>rd</sup> 1919 aged 73 and his niece Ellen Garvey died July 10 <sup>th</sup> 1927 aged 12 years.
Meighan (5)	96	(Beside above.) Erected by James Meighan in memory of his brother Daniel who died March 11 <sup>th</sup> 1813 aged 15 years.
Meighan (6)	97	(Beside No. 5) Erected by Martin Meighan in memory of his father Daniel Meighan who died November 5 <sup>th</sup> 1813 aged 72. Also his wife Ellen Meighan alias Keef who died May 1812.
Meighan (7)	98	(High cross beside small concrete Cross to Bridie Walsh near small stile.) Erected by James Meighan, Outrath in memory of his brother Thomas who died August 11 <sup>th</sup> 1850 aged 30, and his father Patrick Meighan died April 11 <sup>th</sup> 1852 aged 62. Also his mother Mary Meighan alias Cantwell died August 12 <sup>th</sup> 1866 aged 78.
Minogue	99	(Between Ryan and Lee.) Erected by Ellen Minogue alias Quirke in memory of her husband Patrick Minogue late of Grovine who died September 7 <sup>th</sup> 1863 aged 67, also her daughter Mrs Mary Drennan who died April 1 <sup>st</sup> 1851 aged 24.
Moore	100	(Small white marble plaque laid on Glynn grave.) In fond memory of Melvina C. Moore, Parnell Street who died in 1968 aged 9 days.
Muldowney	101	(Tall upright tombstone with cross on top. Between Heffernan and Edm. Mackay.) Erected by Michael Muldowney of Grovine in memory of his father Thomas Muldowney who died 1844 aged 64. His mother Catherine Muldowney died June 1849 aged 60. Also six sons died young.
Mulroney (1)	102	(From left to right of end boundary ditch. Between Doheny and Hickeys.) Erected by Patrick Mulroney in memory of his wife Mary alias Donnelly who died October 5 <sup>th</sup> 1813 aged 42, and three children died young. Also the remains of above Patrick Mulroney who died June 10 <sup>th</sup> 1832 aged 67.
Mulroney (2)	104	(Beside Hickey family.) Erected by Patrick Mulroney in memory of his father Denis who died 1801 aged 72, also two children died young. Also Judith Mulroney alias Gorman died aged 65.
Murphy	105	(Tombstone lying flat on ground near Farrell, Eardley and small stile.) Erected by Matthew Murphy in memory of his father James who died March 30 <sup>th</sup> 1811 and four children. Also the body of his daughter Anne aged 37. Also Catherine Murphy died 1837. R.I.P.

The above Eleanor McGrath, Jeremiah, Thomas, James, Sarah, John, Patrick, Ellen and Murtagh McGrath died September 12 <sup>th</sup> 1905 at Bamford. Mary, Thomas,. Ellen F. McGrath died April 14 <sup>th</sup> 1919 infant daughter of Thomas McGrath. R.I.P.
McGrath (2)	112	(Beside Baldwin and near Doheny. End boundary ditch.) Erected by John McGrath, Kilkenny in memory of his father Edmund McGrath who died February 19 <sup>th</sup> 1862 aged 68. Also his son Edmund died August 3 <sup>rd</sup> 1892 aged 28. John McGrath died February 23 <sup>rd</sup> 1906 aged 78. Ellen McGrath died August 7 <sup>th</sup> 1929 aged 88. Daughter Ellen died September 7 <sup>th</sup> 1935.
O'Brien	114	(Left corner behind Blanchfield, near entrance gate.) Erected by Richard O'Brien, Patrick Street Kilkenny in memory of his father John O'Brien who died March 27 <sup>th</sup> 1847 aged 64. His son John died August 4 <sup>th</sup> 1874 aged 25 years. His beloved wife Mary O'Brien alias Foley died March 16 <sup>th</sup> 1876 aged 52. Eight children died young. James Anthony Hickey died September 2 <sup>nd</sup> 1923 aged 2 years and 3 months. His father William Hickey died 9 <sup>th</sup> September 1955 aged 65.
O'Leary	115	(Upright, close to Cypress tree and between Meehan and McGrath) Erected by James O'Leary, Grovine in memory of his father Patrick who died 1857. His mother Ellen O'Leary died 1847. Son Richard died January 1 <sup>st</sup> 1875 aged 27. Son James died November 19 <sup>th</sup> 1876 aged 30. Also his wife Kate O'Leary died January 15 <sup>th</sup> 1885 aged 63, and her husband James died 26 <sup>th</sup> February, 1895 aged 80.
Purtel	117	(Small tombstone between Costelloe (2) and Meehan marking stone.) Erected by James Purtel of Patrick Street in memory of his son Patrick who died December 12 <sup>th</sup> 1832 aged 17.
