Foreword:

No vestige of the old parish church of Tullamaine remains. The oldest monument in the graveyard is that to Daniel Tierney (1727).

Name	Tomb No	Inscription
Aylward	1	(Upright tombstone between Celtic crosses of Maher and Ryan.) Erected by Eleanor Aylward in memory of her husband Andrew Coughlin who died 15 th December 1803 aged 52, and his brother John Coughlin died 17 th March 1785 aged 30. Bridget Maher died 16 th April 1966.
Bryan	4	(Between Dan Tearny and Catherine Stapleton.) Erected by Con Bryan of Kiln in memory of his wife Judith Bryan alias Murphy who died May 7 th 1869.
Burke	5	(Upright now leaning tombstone between Thornley and Cummins.) Erected by Patrick Burke, Kylevehagh in memory of his father Michael Burke who died May 4 th 1821 aged 84. His mother Mary Burke alias Stapleton who died ----- aged 49 ----- . Judith died ----- Note: Tombstone difficult to read, some words missing.

Cass (1)	9	(Upright tombstone, round top, between Tobin and Kenehan.) Erected by John Cass of Newtown in memory of his father Richard Cass who died 30 th May 1876 aged 76. Also his uncle John Cass who died 27 th June 1861 aged 51. Also his sister Catherine who died August 1 st 1875 aged 34 and sister Mary died 10 th March 1873 aged 27. Also his grandfather and grandmother John and Elizabeth Cass who lie beneath. John Cass died 18 th September 1811 aged 68 years. R.I.P. Tomb maker - O'Shea, Callan
Cass (2)	10	(Between Margaret Power (James Burke) and John Stapleton.) Erected by Mr John Cass in memory of his wife Margaret Cass alias Murray who died 1796 aged 27 years. R.I.P.
Cass (3)	12	(Upright tombstone completely covered by tree.) Erected by Mrs Margaret Ruth in memory of her father Mr Richard Cass who died 29 th November 1797 aged 48. Also his daughter Ann Cass who died 20 th April 1800 aged 20, and his son Maurice Cass died January 18 th 1820.
Carty	13	This stone erected by Patrick Carty in memory of his wife Mary Carty alias Walsh who died 1764 aged 50.
Cummins	17	(Upright between Patrick Burke and Patrick Murphy) Erected by William Cummins of Millashy, Callan in memory of his wife Catherine Cummins alias McGrath who died april 13 th 1803 aged 44 years also daughter Bridget -----.
Dannell (1)	18	(Between James Neil and Thomas Dannell.) Here lieth the body of Bridget Dannell who died January 20 th 1750 aged 56, also her son Roger Shanahan died June 15 th 1750 aged 32 also children died young.
Dannell (2)	19	(Beside above) Here lieth the body of Thomas Dannell who died January 6 th 1782 aged 50. R.I.P. Erected by his wife Joan alias Bryan.
Grace (1)	22	(Tall upright second from road boundary hedge) Erected by Margaret Grace alias Kennedy of Ballymac in memory of dearly loved husband Robert Grace who died July 13 th 1819 aged 36. Also James Grace who died August 13 th 1851 aged 16 years. Also her son John who died September 1852 aged 20. Also William Dea who died April 1914 aged 89 and his wife Mary Dea died June 7 th 19--. Margaret Dea died January 7 th 1901 aged 21.
Grace (2)	23	(Beside Grace (1)) God be merciful to the soul of Edmund Grace who died January (or June) 12 th 1772 aged 82. Also his daughter Mary Brennan alias Grace died 5 th June 1762 aged 19. Erected by his son John Grace. John Grace died 7 th December 1829 aged 68, and his wife Mary alias Healy died 9 th June 1820 aged 70.
Gready	24	(Between Grace and Lawlor)

		Erected by Michael Gready of West Court in memory of his father James Gready who died 22 nd June 1849 age 108 years. Also his wife Margaret Gready alias Tinan who died in 1868 aged 65 and three children died young. His mother Mrs Catherine Gready alias Maher died 22 nd June 1859 aged 101 years. Note: See 'Outrath Cemetery' for Rev. Thadee Gready.
Guilfoyle	25	(Right to left and facing gate) Erected by Thomas Guilfoyle, Commons, Callan in memory of his wife Margaret who died 2/6/1904 aged 70. Thomas Guilfoyle died September 18 th 1914 aged 71 and Mary also died ----- (rest underground).
Kenehan	28	(Upright tombstone close to road boundary hedge) Erected by Robert Kenehan of Cuffesgrange in memory of his dearly beloved wife Catherine Kenehan alias Cass who died May 8 th 1832 aged 39.
Lawlor	30	(Between Gready and Tearney) Erected by Margaret Lawlor alias Ready of Williamstown in memory of her husband James Lawlor who died 30 th October 1833 aged ---8. Also her son John Lawlor died January 11 th 1834 aged 22 years and daughter Margaret Lawlor died 25 th December 1837 aged 21.
Maher (1)	34	(Beside Meagher and in same plot) In loving memory of Laurence Maher, Broadmore who died 5 th June 1961. His son James died 29 th October 1947 and brother Edward died 17 th March 1953 and parents Edward and Catherine Maher. R.I.P. Erected by his loving wife and family. Tomb maker - Molloy, Callan
Maher (2)	35	(Celtic Cross) In loving memory of Patrick Maher, Tullamaine who died 6 th September 1906 aged 80 years. His wife Bridget died 8 th April 1916 and son William died 15 th July 1951. Erected by their children. Tomb maker - Molloy
Meagher	36	(Upright tombstone in same plot as Maher No.1) Erected by John and Kyran Meagher, Broadmore, in memory of their father Laurence who died 6 th June 1811 aged 64, also their mother Mary alias Butler died 4 th May 1838 aged 66. Their brother James died 4 th March 18--, aged 46, and Joseph died 7 th December 1840 aged 42. Also Edmond Meagher died 30 th January 1842 aged 50.
Murphy	37	(Upright tombstone, large lettering between Cummins and Meagher) Here lieth the body of Patrick Murphy who died March 10 th 1774 aged 65. I.H.S. Stone erected by his wife Ally Murphy.
Neil	40	(Between O'Neill and Dannel No.1) Erected by Joseph Neil, Kilbride in memory of his father John Neil who died August 1822 aged 66. Also Bridget Neil, daughter died February 1827 aged 27. Patrick Neil died July 1913 aged 73. Thomas Neil -----

O'Neill	41	(Beside above Neil) Erected by Michael O'Neill of Scough in memory of his parents. Hanora O'Neill nee Finn died 1882 aged 42. Patrick O'Neill, Kilbride died 1913 aged 73. Also his wife Ellen O'Neill alias Hennelly, Seffin, Co. Mayo, died 1931 aged 52, and granddaughter died young. Tomb maker - Molloy.
Power (1)	42	Erected by Margaret Power in memory of her husband James Burke who died 28 th December 1881 and 4 children died young.
Power (2)	43	(Between Dannell and Power) Erected by Mary Power of Tullamaine in memory of her father Edmund Power who died February 17 th 1868 aged 69. Also Margaret Power who died 1862 aged 62. Her sister Ellen died 1848 aged 16 and two brothers died young. Patrick Power died 6 th March 1946 aged 71. Note: Added later - Irish Independent, Sept 19 th 1972 - Mary Ellen daughter of Patrick & Ellen Power died in St. Luke's Hospital.
Power (3)	44	(Beside above) Erected by Patrick Power in memory of his father John Power who died ---- - aged 44. Also his wife Eleanor Power alias Walsh died February 1810 aged 44. Also Patrick died November 1820.
Ryan	46	(Celtic cross between Aylward and end) Erected by Mrs Bridget Ryan, Bridge Street, Callan in memory of her mother Bridget Kennedy who died 18 th March 1868 aged 70. Son John Ryan 22 nd December 1909 aged 37. Above Mrs B. Ryan died 28 th February 1925 aged 86. In loving memory of Mrs Margaret Ryan wife of Michael Ryan who died 30 th December 1920 aged 34. Tomb maker - Molloy.
Stapleton (1)	48	(Celtic cross between Cass (2) and Stapleton (2)) Erected by John Stapleton, Tullamaine in memory of his father James Stapleton who died November 26 th 1889 aged 85. Also his beloved mother Mrs Johanna Stapleton who died March 27 th 1900 aged 65 years. John Stapleton died March 1968 aged 74 years.
Stapleton (2)	49	Erected by Patrick Stapleton of the City of Kilkenny in memory of his father John who died 16 th May 1833 aged 64. His mother Eleanor alias Carrigan died 22 nd December 1855 aged 67.
Stapleton (3)	50	(Two tombstones now lying down and very difficult to read) ----- Catherine Stapleton ----- .
Stapleton (4)	51	Michael died 1900. Anastasia wife do.
Shortall	53	(Upright tombstone underneath tree and completely covered) Erected by Patrick Shortall in memory of his beloved wife Mary Shortall alias Cass who departed this life July 24 th 1822? aged 80 years.
Thornley	54	(Celtic cross between Stapleton and Burke) Erected by Mrs Anastasia Thornley nee Burke, Melbourne, Australia in

		<p>memory of her parents Patrick Burke Kilevehagh who died June 14th 1877 aged 100 years. Also Judith Burke nee Cuddihy died January 1st 1835 aged 42. Her sister Mary Burke died 1st March 1851 aged 50. Bridget Burke died April 1852 aged 19. Her brothers Edward died 26th May 1848 aged 21, and John died 7th February 1895 aged 68. Patrick Burke died young R.I.P.</p> <p>(Left side of Cross) Also grandparents Michael Burke died May 4th 1821 aged 64?, and Mary Burke nee Stapleton died February 10th 1817 aged 49 years. R.I.P.</p>
Tearney	56	<p>(Altar tomb between Lawlor and Bryan)</p> <p>Here lie the body of Danl Tearney who departed this life March 20th 1727 aged 87 and his wife Margaret died December 8th 1737 aged 76.</p> <p>Erected by John and Mary Tearney.</p> <p>Note: Oldest tombstone. Edmund Rice's mother was a Margaret Tearney</p>
Tobin	57	<p>(Upright tombstone with cross on top at boundary)</p> <p>In loving memory of my dear mother Mary Tobin nee Murray, Callan who died 12th September 1917 aged 52, and my dear father James Tobin died 12th November 1921 aged 46. Also their deceased relatives. R.I.P.</p> <p>Erected by their son Michael and his wife.</p> <p>Tomb maker - Molloy, Callan</p>
