A printed page would be ideal, more if you prefer.

KAS is not doing research on the women; it is just collecting whatever information people wish to add to the Lá na mBan archive about them. The aim is to collect stories, facts and photos of at least 100 of the women but we would be very glad to get even a little bit about all 1,015.
