Name	Tomb No.	Inscription
Shee	1	Here lies the body of Thomas Shee, died October 12 <sup>th</sup> 1765 aged 52 and Mary Shee died December 20 <sup>th</sup> 17-7 aged 50.
O'Hara	2	Erected by Michael O'Hara in memory of his father Murty O'Hara died 17 <sup>th</sup> March 1812 aged 70 with 3 of his children.
Murphy	3	(Under tree at side of Church) Here lies Miss Margt. Murphy daughter of Mr William Murphy died 19 <sup>th</sup> April 1775 aged 17.
Murphy	4	Here lies Edward Murphy and Johanna alias Keating his wife, also William Murphy their son died 11 <sup>th</sup> October 1769 aged 59.
Murphy	5	Here lies Edward Murphy of Castle Annagh died 8 <sup>th</sup> May 1807 aged 60. Sacred to the memory of the kindest and best of fathers.
Chucb	6	(In the Church) Rikard de Chucb (See Carrigan, Vol. 2)

Purcell	7	(This tomb was not visible) Ellenor ----- Robert-- Foulksrath, date 1629. (See Carrigan, Vol. 2)
