Foreword: by Rita Harte

No trace of the old church of Mayne (now called Moyne) remains. Moyne Graveyard is situated above the banks of the River Dinan on the West side.

There are recumbent slabs at end of graveyard mostly broken.

Inscriptions:

Name	Tomb No.	Inscription
Hoyne	1	(Starting inside the gate to the right.) Here lies John Hoyne, died December 3 rd 1766 aged 36, also his mother Anstice Hoyne alias Troy died 17 th June 1765 aged 60.
Delaney	2	Erected by Edmund Delaney in memory of wife Honor Delaney alias How, died 30 th March 1793 aged 32.
Phelan	3	(Left of Gate) Erected by John Phelan in memory of his wife Margaret alias Hoyne died 8 th August 1809 aged 33 with one of her children.
Hoyne	4	(There is a crudely punched metal disc on a rough wooden cross. The name is probably Hoyne as it is near other graves of that name.) In memory of James Hoyne died December 5 th 1921 aged 28.
Carroll	5	Erected by Own Magrath in memory of mother Margaret Carroll died 26 th April 1773 aged 40, also six of his children.

Phelan	6	Erected by Anne Phelan alias Brenan in memory of her husband Jno Phelan, died 19 th June 1801 aged 54.
Downey	7	Erected by John Downey of Conahy in memory of his wife Margaret alias Hoyne died November 4 th 1818 aged 60 also their son Michael Downey died November 11 th 1828 aged 40, also said John Downey died April 15 th 1832 aged 80.
Buggy	8	Erected by Martin Buggy of Kilmakane in memory of son James Buggy died 12 th November 1815 aged 18 years.
Byrne	9	Erected by Mrs Nancy Byrne of Gragara in memory of her husband Michael Byrne died September 20 th 1836 aged 30 also three of his children who died young.
McEvoy	10	Erected by Catherine McEvoy alias Cahil in memory of her husband Denis died January 28 th 1811 aged 50.
Brenan	12	Erected by Mrs Mary Brenan alias Butler in memory of husband Thomas died July 10 th 1809 aged 65.
Bergin	13	Here lies Mary Bergin died – January 1786 aged 40. (Another slab leaning against tombstone covers date).
Carroll	14	Here lies Anstice Carroll died 14 th July 1786 aged 34 also some of her children also Patrick Carroll her husband R.I.P. (The original inscription ends here, followed by part of a later inscription) ‘also the body of Alia –’ (stone broken here)
Carroll	15	Erected by William Carroll in memory of daughter Bridget died August 4 th 1798 aged 13 also a grandson (stone broken)
Grace	16	Nicholas Grace died May 10 th 1781 aged 40 and his wife Margaret Grace died July 23 rd 1800 aged 60 also Michael Grace died July 11 th 1808 aged 50. Erected by John Grace the place of their abode Rathmoyle ? in the parish of Ballinamara.
Carroll	17	(Stone broken) Carroll (details of name, date and age are gone)
