Generally the stones are well out, a number have sunk into the ground and there is a small number of fallen slabs.

Four mentioned in Carrigan are no longer visible.

Carvings of Note are few. The medieval slab (85) in fairly high relief is in the Church but a portion of it marking a grave in the Graveyard halfway between the door and the outside wall 1980.

No 70 has a design of hourglasses and Skulls.

A number of tombs are with pediment top and cross in the manner of Hoban Tomb maker Irishtown, Kilkenny.
