Foreword:

No trace remains of the medieval church of Ballycallan dedicated to St. Bridget but it is believed to have been within the present ancient churchyard. A protestant church has been present in the churchyard since the second half of the 18th century. There are four ancient monuments, one dating from the middle of the 13th century in memory of Sarah Moynath (Carrigan, Vol. III, p 442). The inscriptions on them are no longer legible. Many tombstones are sunk.
