### Foreword:

The present chapel was built about 1817 within the graveyard under the administration of St John's Parish Church, and may have replaced an older chapel of ease dependent on the parish church of Rathcoole. In the graveyard the oldest inscription recorded was in memory to Mrs Joan Davis dated 1715. A number of grave slabs are leaning against the wall, lettering hidden, so these were not recorded.
