Foreword:

Mickle's Church was built by William Smyth of Damma, who died in 1655. It was later improved by his grandson Valentine Smyth, who died in 1700 and by the latter's daughter-in-law Mrs Jane Smyth, otherwise Read who died in 1747. It probably served as the chapel of the Ballycallan district for more than 100 years. It fell into ruin towards the end of the 18th century (Carrigan, Vol. III, p 443) Monuments are present in both the Church ruins and in the graveyard. Some tombs are too sunken to read inscriptions.
