Dear Sir:-

My house in Currnananty, used partly as dwelling house and partly as a Sinn Rein Hall, was burned by Auxiliary Police on the 22nd. September, 1920, they having broken up doors and tables and sprinkled them with petrol. It was all burned in half an hour. Myself, wife and child lived with my Mother since. It was a very serious loss to me. I received a Grant of £25 from the White Cross. Then I got a Loan of £300, for which I am deeply grateful.

I have my house almost built up again.

I am sorry I have not got a picture of my house, but thanking you again for your generosity, I remain,
